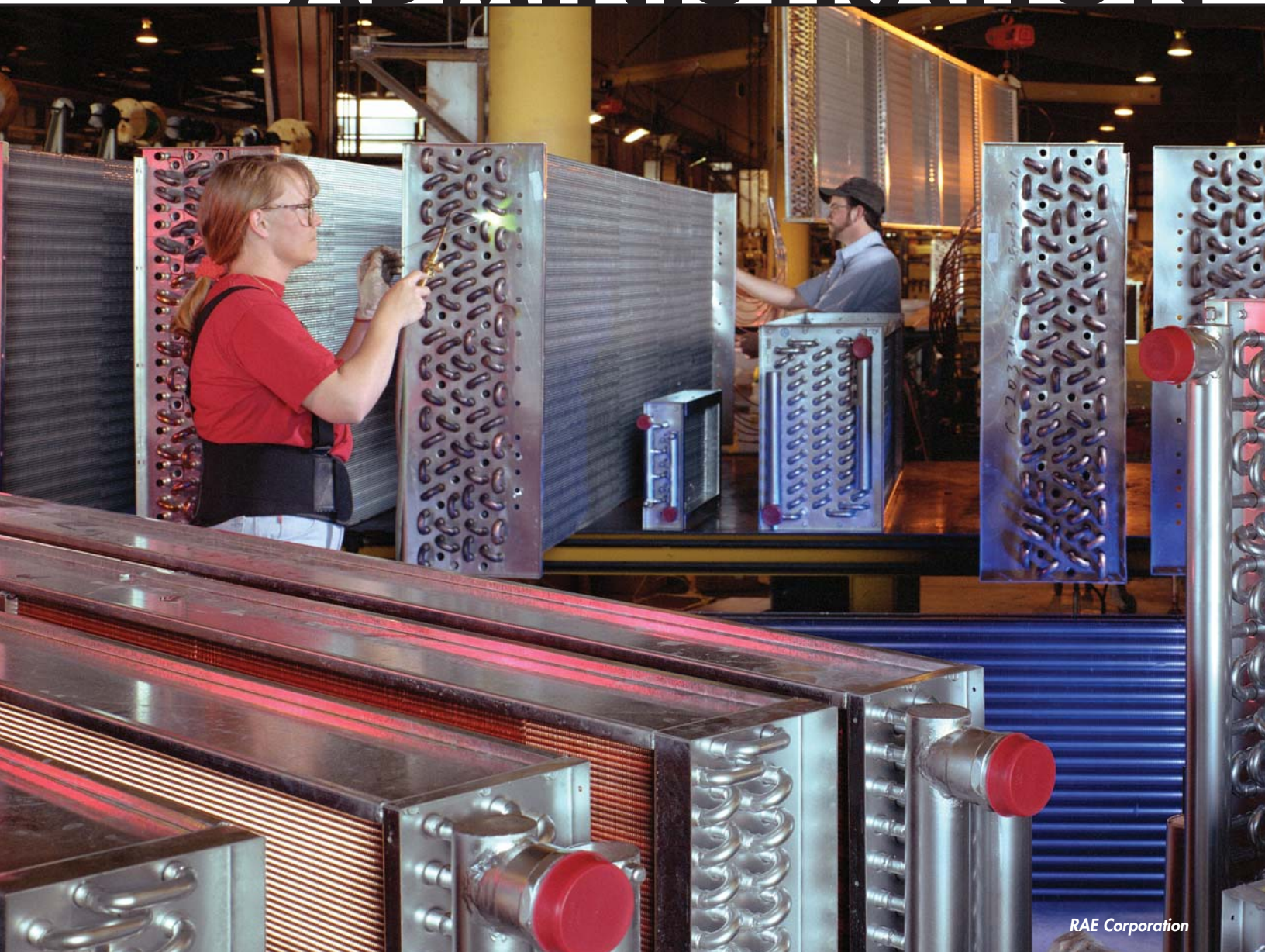


ADMINISTRATION

Established in 1960, MidAmerica is owned and operated by a self-sustaining public trust coordinated by a Board of Trustees that functions much like a corporate board of directors and meets throughout the year to review all park operations and planning.

Lifetime trustees include R. Dobie Langenkamp, an attorney and owner of a petroleum investments firm, Robert R. "Rob" Gilbert, III, President of a leading Tulsa bank, and Sanders Mitchell, who is also the park's Administrator, Secretary and Treasurer. David Chernicky, the owner of a leading oil and gas exploration and production company, and Natalie Shirley, Secretary of the Oklahoma Departments of Commerce and Tourism, are other members of MidAmerica's board.

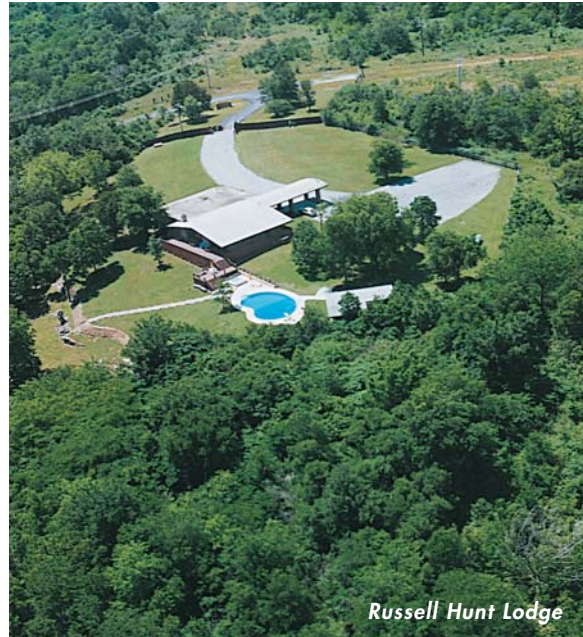
